**Response to your official information request**

Thank you for your clarified official information request received on 30 July 2024 for information on NZ Binxi and the potential breaches, the OIO coordinating with WorkSafe and/or Immigration NZ on this matter, the OIO or its representatives that physically inspected the Oamaru site and the completed physical building application.

This response relates to the 2016 application for consent (case number 201610121), and corresponding 2022 application for variation of consent.

Attached is a copy of the OI Assessment Report for Case 201610121 and a copy of the OI Variation Assessment Report issued in 2022 which are released in part.

Some information has been withheld under:

- section 9(2)(b)(ii) of the Official Information Act (the Act) as the making available of the information would be likely to unreasonably prejudice the commercial position of the person who supplied or who is the subject of the information; and/or
- section 9(2)(a) of the Official Information Act to protect the privacy of natural persons.

We are of the view withholding the information is not outweighed by the public interest to make that information available.
