Response to your official information request

Thank you for your official information request received on 13 August 2024 for documents relating to Te Wa hou Plantations Limited (201020106). We note the subsequent clarification that you seek:

- · the assessment report;

We are of the opinion that good reason for the withholding of some information exists under the following sections of the Official Information Act 1982:

- 9(2)(b)(ii) where the making available of the information would be likely unreasonably to prejudice the commercial position of the person who supplied, or who is the subject, of the information.

We are of the view the withholding of the information is not outweighed by the public interest to make that information available.
