Thank you for your official information request received on 10 September 2024 for information regard ng Toitū Te Whenua Land Information New Zealand's (LINZ) participation in the Wall Walk course.

LINZ conducted a feedback survey after the courses took place, and the below is high-level analysis of this feedback:

• 97% of attendees identified that the course would assist in their role at LINZ.

81% of attendees identified the course increased their understanding of New Zealand history and Te Tiriti o Waitangi.

68% of a tendees were highly likely to recommend this course to colleagues.
