Response to your official information request

Thank you for your official information request received on 7 April 2024 requesting a copy of our generative artificial intelligence policy, a table / list of any other related or similar policies, and copies of any correspondence with the Government Chief Privacy Officer (GCPO) or the Office of the Privacy Commissioner (OPC) regarding our generative Al policy.

Attached is a copy of the following documentation that we have been able to locate:

In addition to the items listed above, an online meeting was held at 10:30am on Wednesday, 21 February 2023 which was attended by Toitū Te Whenua Land Information New Zealand (LINZ) and GCPO staff members. This meeting was one a of a regular series of meetings between LINZ and GCPO staff. At the meeting, GCPO requested a copy of the LINZ Artificial Intelligence Use Policy, which we have provided to them.

We have enclosed some of the information you have requested which is released in part. Some information has been withheld under:

- Section 6(a) being meeting passwords and login details to protect the security of those meetings.
- section 9(2)(a) to protect the privacy of individuals; and
- section 9(2)(ba)(i) to protect information provided in confidence..

In addition, information relating to Approved AI Tools referred to in the LINZ Artificial Intelligence Use Policy has been refused under section 6(a) of the Official Information Act 1982 of the Official Information Act. This has been refused under the Act in line with the New Zealand Government security recommended guidance, as the details of name and company/companies for software systems used by LINZ has the potential to give an indication of vulnerabilities that could be exploited to gain access to systems or data.

We are of the view that withholding of the information is not outweighed by the public interest to make that information available.
