Data Acceptance Criteria - OIA

The following guides the acceptance criteria for data licence applications:

- The application demonstrates a genuine need to gain access to bulk personal data of all property owners in New Zealand.
 - An example of this is Central or local government, utility companies or financial institutions. Using the bulk data to inform rates information, infrastructure planning, disaster management and analysis for trends and statistics.
- The application provides assurance that how the data will be used, stored, maintained, and protected is unlikely to breach obligations of the Privacy Act 2020 and other terms of the licence.
- The application demonstrates adequate security of the data is in place including:
 - Data stored in a certified data centre, single sign on (SSO) authentication, server encryption, audit logs, Global Data Protection Regulation (GPDR)compliant, Privacy officer.
- The application provides adequate evidence that people using the data will not violate the terms by:
- Performing employee background checks, trained and comply with company privacy policy, end to end encryption, regular audits.
