TENURE REVIEW - MT CECILE

NEW ZEALAND

The following provides an assessment of Fish and Game's interest in relation to Mt Cecile.

1. The North Branch Waihao River along the western margin of the property provides a wilderness fishery with scenic and solitude values. It provides suitable spawning and juvenile rearing habitat. Bedrock features in this section of the river providing a very stable bed and habitat for an abundance of aquatic invertebrates. Aside from brown trout and their redds Fish and Game have observed galaxids, bullies and eels.

Results from the 1994-1996 National Angler Survey indicate that approximately 640 angler days are spent on the Waihao River each season.

- Access to the North Branch Waihao River wilderness fishery is important. With this in regard Fish and Game request that the following be included in the tenure review.
 - a) Marginal strips along the North Branch Waihao River
 - b) If possible angler access to the North Branch Waihao River
 - c) If possible access to the North Branch Waihao River for management purposes.
 - d) Retention of any legal roads that facilitate the provision of access requested in b & c.
