



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- 6. Extensive wetland with *schoenus* and red tussock at base of upper lateral moraine north of Coal River. The wetland (at NZMS 260 series I37 173090) is not identified or described in DoC's Botanical Assessment or the CRR. (Botanical Assessment report map area 3.) Note fenceline. Despite understating the area's SIV's by not noting or describing this or other wetlands, the Botanical Assessment recommends that the area be protected. No reason is given why the SIVs have been disregarded.

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- 7. Dense short tussock and matagouri shrublands with high natural character and limited grazing value. Photo is looking west over the lower incised gully on the true right of Coal River towards the river's outwash fan (on left) and the Godley River. (Botanical Assessment report map areas 3 and 4).
- 8. Dense and diverse *Cassinia*, matagouri shrublands with *Leucopogon colensoi*, *Gaultheria novae-zelandia*, silver and fescue tussock on true right of Coal River. Near NZMS 260 series I37 170095. View is looking south towards Mt Hay and Tekapo township. Area contains some of the most extensive shrublands on Richmond. (Botanical Assessment report map area 3).
