Land currently proposed for freeholding (FH1) which deserves protection as part of an extended CA2 and CA4.

13. *Schoepus* wetland on floor of unnamed stream gully on true right of Coal River near NZMS 260 series I37 168088. (Botanical Assessment report map area 3 but not described or noted in assessment).

14. Matagouri shrublands and short tussock in unnamed stream gully on true right of Coal River below snow fenceline. (Botanical Assessment report map area 3).

15. Looking east from Lilybank Road near Coal River bridge over lower and upper lateral moraine Two Thumb Range. Browntop dominated short tussock changes to fescue tussock and matagouri shrublands within 1-1.5 km of road. (Botanical Assessment report map areas – not assessed in foreground, and Map areas 3 and 2e). Mt Gerald/Richmond boundary fence is below low saddle on left of photo with Round Hill on right. The proposed new mid slope fence would scar the landscape.



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Land currently proposed for freeholding (FH1) which deserves protection as part of an extended CA2 and CA4.

16. Healthy short tussock grasslands and unnamed stream gully near spot height 835m south of Round Hill ski field road.

17. Part of what the Botanical Assessment describes as "the best area of fescue tussock" on Richmond. The tussock is in good condition with a reasonable diversity of inter tussock species. View is looking north towards Godley Valley from just off the Round Hill skifield road. (Botanical Assessment report map area 4.)

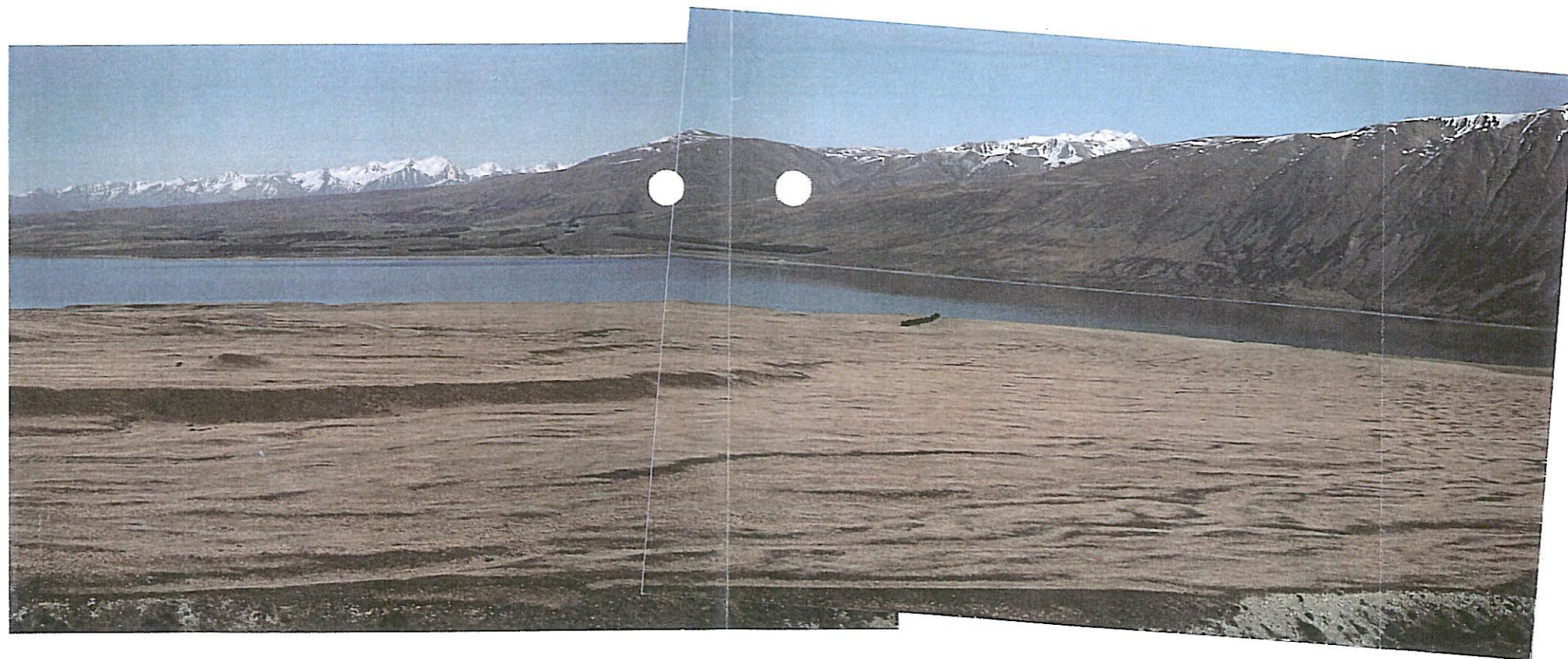
18. Looking from the top of the terrace on the true right of Coal River towards the lake over fescue tussock grasslands between Round Hill skifield road and Coal River outwash fan. (Botanical Assessment report map area 4).



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
