## Response to your official information request

Thank you for your official information request received on 20 May 2024 for any information LINZ holds (records, reports, maps, documents, letters, Bills, photos, etc) with regards to when and why a diversion channel and/or sluice gate was installed in the Muddy Creek watercourse (at GPS Locations: E1442266; N5006952) in Oamaru, on the South Island, sometime between 8 September 1938 and 1 January 1957.

We have undertaken a comprehensive search of our electronic document management system and identified one file



which might have some information on the Diversion Channel and sluice gate installed in Muddy Creek, Oamaru, between 8 September 1938 and 1 January 1957.

However, when we approached our offsite archive provider asking for the file they advised that they can't find the file as it's not in an actual box in storage so they can't identify the location.

We also undertook a search of Archives New Zealand. This search returned the following files the titles of which reference "Muddy Creek" which might have some information on the Diversion Channel and sluice gate installed in Muddy Creek, Oamaru, between 8 September 1938 and 1 January 1957
