Thank you for your official information request received on 13 November 2024 for:

"I am looking for any case that makes reference to the sensitive land in Part 1 Schedule 1 of the OIA2005: Row 10 and Row 11. Land that is considered 'sensitive' for the purpose of s 12(a) of the OIA because of its customary relevance and wahi tapu."

As requested, please find **attached** a list of consents decided since 15 August 2005 to 18 November 2024 with a land sensitivity which includes "wahi tapu".

Please note that the list of applications is based on land sensitivities "adjoins Historic place/wahi tapu" and "includes historic place/wahi tapu", so will identify consents that adjoin/include a historic place and are not wahi tapu. We have no way of excluding this data from our dataset.
